<b>Foxdenton Sloe - South West London, England - 25%</b> Stronger, paler & drier than your average Sloe gin, full of juniper on the nose giving way to plum sweetness before a long, crisp finish. Gin Liqueur. <i>Recommended serve: Soda with fresh lemon juice</i>	5

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<b>Gin Mare - Vilanova, Spain - 42.7%</b> Mediterranean gin distilled in a thirteenth century chapel with a very herbal & aromatic palate. Perfume-like delivery. Coriander & tart juniper, citrus zest. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	5.6
<b>Half Hitch - Camden, London, England - 40%</b> Made in a micro-distillery in the heart of Camden Lock. Tones of sweet orange, nutmeg & rich black tea with lingering touches of cinnamon & fresh lemon zest. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	5.4
<b>Hayman's London Dry - Balham, London, England - 41.2%</b> The palate has a distinctive creaminess to it, with a thick, rich viscosity. Notes of fresh orange & lemon, piney juniper, coriander spiciness with a hint of fennel. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.1
<b>Hayman's Old Tom - Balham, London, England - 41.4%</b> Subtly sweet, though maintains a herbaceous quality throughout. Light on the juniper, this gin has notes of baking spices & citrus oils. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	5.1
<b>Hendricks - Girvan, Scotland - 44%</b> Uniquely made in 2 separate stills. Fresh notes of oak, citrus & vanilla. Their signature rose & cucumber flavour is added post distillation to give it a prominent taste. <i>Recommended serve: Elderflower &amp; Lemon Tonic</i>	5.6
<b>Langley No.8 - Midlands, England - 41.7%</b> Distilled with only 8 botanicals to give it the name Langley's No. 8 with the aroma of viola, liquorice and sage - the finish is dry & tangy. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.4
<b>London No.1 - London, England - 43%</b> Originally distilled in Spain. Heavily floral gin with notes of lavender, violet & an after taste of ginger spice balances the palate. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.8

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<b>Malfy Con Rosa - Turin, Italy - 41%</b> Italian gin named 'Rosa' meaning 'pink' in Italian, the gin features Sicilian pink grapefruit peel, & rhubarb distillate is added after distillation to provide the consistent pink hue. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.7
<b>Malfy Con Arancia - Turin, Italy - 41%</b> African inspired gin, complex in taste but strikingly smooth, encompassing floral, fruity & spicy flavours. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.7
<b>Malfy Con Limone - Turin, Italy - 42%</b> It features Sicilian & Amalfi Coast lemons alongside juniper & 5 further botanicals, delivering a full, zesty lemon flavour. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.7
<b>Martin Miller's - Midlands, England - 40%</b> Diluted with fresh Icelandic water. This classic gin has a citrus led palate with cucumber after notes with an extremely smooth quality. <i>Recommended serve: Aromatic Tonic</i>	5.1
<b>Martin Miller's Westbourne - Midlands, England - 45.2%</b> Designed for bartenders who requested a higher abv the Westbourne boasts the same citrus notes with added cucumber flavour whilst packing a bigger punch with its percentage. <i>Recommended serve: Aromatic Tonic</i>	5.95
<b>Masons of Yorkshire - Malton, England - 42%</b> Distilled in the North Yorkshire countryside, this London Dry Gin has hints of juniper & punchy citrus which are smoothed with fennel & cardamom, followed by a warm peppery finish. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.2
<b>Mirabeau - Provence, France - 43%</b> A dry Rosé gin made from a grape based neutral spirit, it has a subtle fruity base with fore tones of Rose Petals, Lavender & Jasmine to give it a significant floral taste. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.5

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<b>Monkey 47 - Schwarzwald, Germany - 47%</b> Aptly named for its 47 botanical recipe and abv, this dry gin is far from traditional. Each sip reveals a new flavour from berry fruits and citrus to floral and herbal characteristics. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic &amp; a dash of soda</i>	6.2
<b>No.3 London - London, England - 46%</b> A balance of the 3 key gin flavours juniper, citrus & spice. A very classic London Dry Gin which brings it back to the essence of traditional distillation. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	5.95
<b>No.209 - San Francisco, USA - 46%</b> There is a modern twist to this American distilled gin, leaving juniper in the background it has prominent notes of citrus & floral flavours. <i>Recommended serve: Premium Indian Tonic</i>	5.95
<b>Ophir - Warrington, England - 40%</b> Spices of the Orient has a recipe firmly rooted in the Spice Route. Spicy Cubeb berries from Indonesia & Black Pepper from India give this gin its warming spiced quality. <i>Recommended serve: Ginger Ale</i>	4.8
<b>Oxley - London, England - 47%</b> Distilled at lower temperatures this London Dry captures flavours potentially lost in traditional distillation from heat. Juniper forward gin with mid tones of vanilla & meadowsweet. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	6.5
<b>Pinkster - Cambridge, England - 37.5%</b> A classic dry gin steeped with fresh raspberries to give the gin a refreshing & colourful twist. Well-balanced with the black pepper & gentle spice. <i>Recommended serve: Sicilian Lemonade</i>	5.4
<b>Plymouth - Plymouth, England - 41.2%</b> This spirit is one of the oldest gin brands still being produced. A famous earthy quality on the nose & to taste this unique gin is soft, oily & gently warming. <i>Recommended serve: Mediterranean Tonic</i>	5

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- Plymouth Sloe - Plymouth, England - 26%** 5  
A gin liqueur with mellow sloe berries, fruity with notes of sweet cherry & a scent of almonds. Lower in abv and sweeter in taste, the gin is steeped with the berries for 4 months.  
*Recommended serve: Soda with fresh lemon juice*
- Portobello Road - London, England - 42%** 5.4  
A classic London Dry with spicy & earthier notes give it a warming quality. Botanicals of nutmeg, liquorice root & green juniper give this gin it's savoury quality.  
*Recommended serve: Aromatic Tonic*
- Roku - Osaka, Japan - 43%** 5.5  
Japanese gin named after its 'six' distinctive botanicals. Two types of green tea and cherry (blossom & leaves) a herbaceous gin with lighter notes of bergamot.  
*Recommended serve: Refreshingly Light Tonic*
- Roundhouse (Distilled on site) - Birmingham, England - 40%** 5.2
